Artists from 6 years old and up.

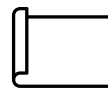
WHAT IS IT ABOUT ?

Paint



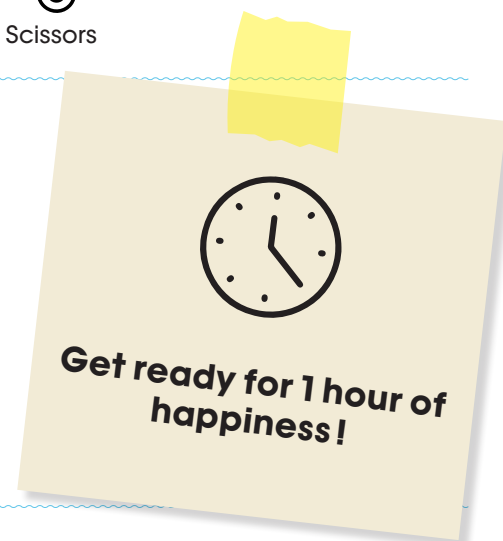
Glue

HOW IS IT DONE ?

- 1 Choose the theme for your poster (advertising, cinema, travel, museum) and look for ideas to illustrate it.
- 2 Cut out shapes, images, photographs, words and letters from newspapers.
- 3 Have fun combining and overlapping your cuttings. Then glue them one at a time on the paper that you can place either vertically or horizontally.
- 4 After the glue has dried, add more colors with paint or colored pencils.
- 5 Your poster is finished!

DID YOU KNOW ?

Photographic posters first saw the light in the 1920s: the German Dadaists and the Russian Constructivists invented photomontage, which gradually replaced the painted poster.
