- To reflect on the composition of images and learn to analyze it



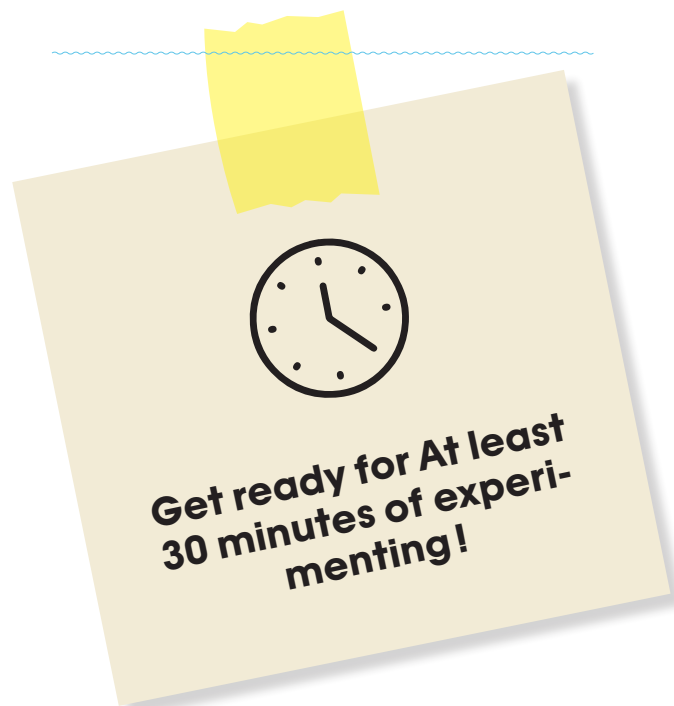
WHAT YOU WILL NEED

HOW IS IT DONE ?

- 1 Choose objects to photograph. Try to vary the shapes, colors and sizes of the objects.
- 2 Place the objects together on a flat surface, for example, a table, and unleash your creativity!
- 3 Create a composition with the chosen objects.
- 4 Take a picture of your work, first from a distance. Then choose a detail and photograph it very closely. You will get two totally different effects!
- 5 Have fun moving the objects around and reworking your composition.
- 6 Keep doing it until you feel like a real composition pro!

DID YOU KNOW ?

Composition is the organization of all the elements of a photograph: the arrangement of the subjects, the chosen angle of view, the dominant colors or patterns. A well thought-out composition helps the viewer to read the image and to decipher it: Where is the main subject? What is the message of this photograph?
